The choir's performances have provided encouragement and hope to families in hospice care, residents of mental health facilities, residents living in retirement communities, and to the general public for 17 years. The choir's season is slated to begin on September 8 with their first rehearsal taking place at UUCF, 2709 Hunter Mill Road, Oakton, VA at 7:30pm.
